Non profit Organization founded in 2005 created by friends following the death of Jonathan GALINIER at age 20 of cystic fibrosis, best friend of Giom

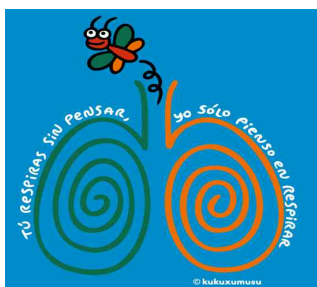

Share our journey with hospitalised children

Our goal is to help the sick children rediscover the necessary energy needed to fight the disease. The child will find their own positive identity while in the core of an uplifting project. This permits them to escape from their medicalised universe and to project themselves into the future through world discovery and the cyclists' eyes.

5 volunteers will propose to the children to interact with us via internet.

How ? We will ask the children, through any medium, to share their dreams. Throughout the journey we will collect and send the resulting creations back home (on average fifteen images per country).

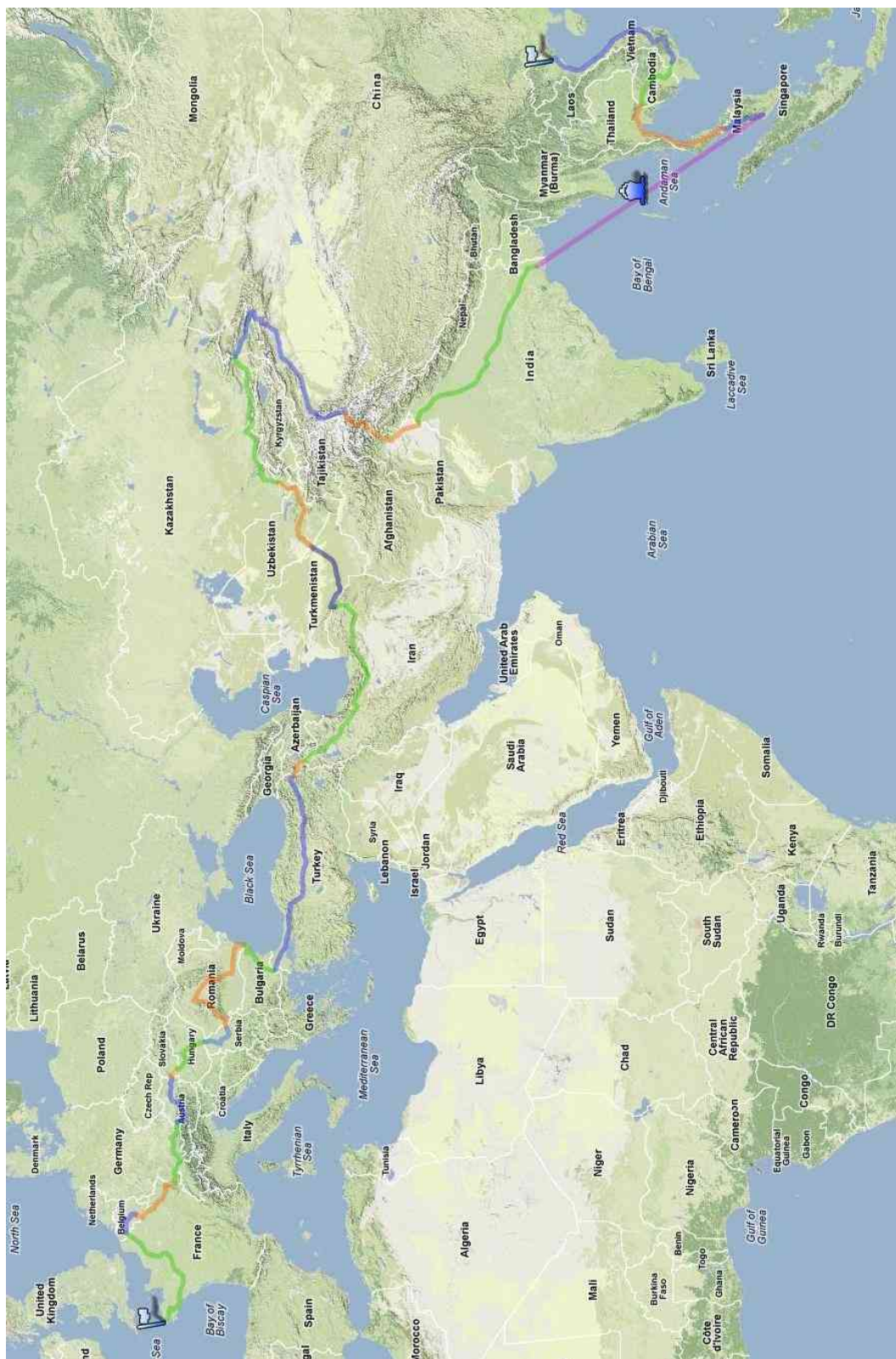




5) The itinerary
